OPERATIONAL HIGHLIGHTS

The 2022-2023 fiscal year (July 1, 2022 -June 30, 2023) was a year of growth. We increased the number of families coming back to Mass, and the school and Faith Formation enrollment increased compared to the previous fiscal year. With growth, we face new challenges and opportunities. We increased the number of activities and group meetings held in our facilities and grew the promotion of events outside our boundaries. This year, we hosted our first Heart of Worship, which was promoted Archdiocesan-wide. We look forward to the next one on September 28, 2024.

None of this would be possible without your generosity, support, and goodwill, allowing us to positively impact many who benefit from our different ministries.



The biggest challenge this year came in before the fiscal year ended when a storm disrupted the powerlines that feed our facility, cutting power and bringing it back on at a higher-thannormal rate that even our surge protectors cannot support. This happened multiple times during the storm. The aftermath of this event left us with multiple electrical systems that had to be replaced during the year, from audio mixers and amplifiers to televisions and multiple AC controllers. The Blessed Sacrament chapel and the room inside the Fellowship Hall now have two new AC units.

This year, the school finished its new dining hall, which has a capacity of 150 students and includes a serving kitchen and restrooms. This new addition to the campus serves all students during lunch and is a multipurpose space for meetings, electives, and other activities. This project required the school to purchase and refurbish the two portable buildings used as classrooms during the construction of the new building.

With your support during our 2023 Gala in April, the school was also able to remodel the old school building and add new doors, windows, and electronic access control components. The hallways in the building have new walls, paint, and acoustic panels.



The projects greatly impact the school as its enrollment grows each year. Enrollment has increased from 338 students at the start of the 2022-2023 school year to 374 students at the start of the 2023-2024 school year, with a 90% retention rate.

One of the main achievements during the year was considerably reducing our loan note from the Archdiocese because of your abundance of generosity during our latest appeal.

We would like to thank those behind the scenes who make all this possible. such as our Church and School Finance Councils, Parish Council, School Board, and PTO, along with all the committees and people who help make worship happen each week. We remain thankful to our school and confirmation teachers, Early Childhood Center caregivers, group leaders, ushers and helpers, and school volunteers. Our events and organizations would not function without those who work behind the scenes in the church and school office, including a special thanks to the people who maintain our building and grounds and in many other ways.

We also would like to thank you for helping us achieve our 2022 DSF goal (\$130,200), for your Capital Campaign support during the fiscal year (\$760,622), for your contributions to St. Mary Seminary (\$22,389), and to Fund the Mission of St. Theresa Catholic School (\$116,237).

We would like to express our gratitude for your contributions to our Second Collections supporting the School Tuition Assistance program (\$8,237) and Archdiocesan ministries (\$41,311), such as Bishop's Fund for Latin America, Black and Indian Missions, Home Missions, World Missions, Catholic Relief Services, Peter's Pence, Campaign for Human Development, St. Vincent DePaul Society, University of St. Thomas, Retired Priests and Religious as well as the Archdiocesan Social Ministries.

Thank you for generously giving your time, skills, and financial gifts to our various ministries. With your support, we sent \$48,580 in addition to \$40,854 in in-kind donations to over ten organizations and ecumenical partners supporting people with great needs. Organizations such as Casa Juan Diego, Catholic Charities, Christian Community Service Center "CCSC", Covenant House, Cristo Rey Jesuit, Discalced Carmelite Nuns, Interfaith Ministries "Meals on Wheels," Magnificat House "Loaves & Fishes," San Jose Clinic, St. Hyacinth Catholic Church, St. Joseph Catholic Church, and United Way of Greater Houston.

We thank you for your presence, love, and care for our Church and School community.


CHURCH REVENUES AND EXPENSES



2022-2023 ACTUAL




SCHOOL REVENUES AND EXPENSES



2022-2023 ACTUAL


